

Contract Vote The Process and What to Expect



It is very important for each and every one of you to show up and vote on the Company's "Last, Best, and Final" Contract Offer this Sunday, April 24th at 10:00a.m. Once the meeting is opened and introductions have been made your Committee will go through the Company's proposal step by step and then we will take questions from the floor.

Following the Question & Answer session you will vote to Accept, or Reject the Company offer. If the majority of the membership vote to accept the proposal than we have a new contract beginning at 12:01a.m. on April 25, 2022. If the majority vote to reject the proposal, we will have a 2nd vote which is the Strike Authorization vote. A strike authorization vote will be taken and if 66 2/3% of the membership vote to strike, the strike will commence at 12:01a.m. on April 25, 2022.

If 66 2/3% of the membership do not vote to strike, then we automatically accept the Company's Last, Best, and Final offer that goes into effect at 12:01a.m. on April 25, 2022. As you can see it is EXTREMELY important for each of you to participate in this process and not leave your future up to others to decide! These meetings generally last between two (2) and four (4) hours. Doors open at 9:00 a.m.
